Our Plan

- We miss our students and are excited to see them, introduce them to the new school and playground, and help them learn again.
- We want to keep you and your family safe.
- Learning new rules will take time for everyone to learn, and we want you and your children to feel as comfortable as possible.
- Desks are placed apart to distance students as much as possible.
- Students who are sick have to stay home.

Masks

- All staff and visitors will be required to wear masks
- Grades 4-12 students will have to wear masks on buses and in hallways, and sometimes in classrooms
- Masks need to be washed daily.

Staying Healthy

- Wear masks when possible
- Wash hands often
- Use hand sanitizer
- Stay 6 feet or 2 meters away
- Cover coughs and sneezes
- Follow arrows in hallways

Daily Screening

Each day, parents have to ask their children questions before students can come to school. If a student shows any signs of being sick, they have to stay home. If a child has a pre-existing condition (ex. asthma) please contact the office.

If a student gets sick at school

- Students who show symptoms will be given a mask and wait in the office to be picked up
- Parents will be called to pick the child up from school
- Children who are ill must stay at home

Is the school open to parents?

- Parents can come into the school by appointment only. Please call the office.
- Please bring a mask to wear, and sanitize your hands on arrival.
- A record of all visitors will be kept.

Food/Drinks

- Due to COVID, there will not be microwaves or hot water for student use.
- If you want to pack something hot, please pack it in a thermos.
- Please send a water bottle with every child with their name on it.
